We are continuing this term with a topic-based approach to our curriculum at Fairfields. This term, our topic is entitled 'Discoveries'. Please find attached a mind map of the different subjects and how they link with this topic.

Your child will continue to receive regular homework as they did last year. The children are asked to read at home weekly, practise their spellings, complete the Abacus maths games and learn tables as appropriate. This homework is set on Friday and will be due in on Wednesday. Spellings are tested on Wednesday too. There are also half termly sets of topic challenges.

Miss Young and Miss Warwick are keen to work in a partnership with you. We appreciate your support with homework. Please feel free to make an after-school appointment if you wish to discuss any problems or queries you may have.

## Reading

Each day, the children continue to participate in guided reading. We undertake a range of different activities such as summarising, discussing the language used and answering comprehension questions. One of the year 5 objectives is to read a range of books, including myths, legends, fiction from the past and other cultures so please could you make sure that your child records what they read at home in their homework book so we can track their breadth of reading.

## Mathematics

During our mathematics sessions, the children will work on mental and written strategies for calculations. We will use these strategies to solve real life problems. We will also work on statistics, measurement and geometry. The curriculum has an emphasis on reasoning so children need to be able to explain their work. You could help us with this aim by asking the question 'Why?' while they are doing mathematical activities at home. The children are encouraged to use Mathletics at home (see below). They can also practise their times tables on TT Rockstars.
