

6W's Class Charter

From Article 16

The children in 6W deserve the right to privacy.

Children should not look in other people's property unless they have permission. If children need time by themselves, the class and adults will allow them a little space for a while.

From Article 12

All children in 6W have the right to give their opinions in class discussions.

The children will listen to the teacher, be respectful and not interrupt others. The adults will give children a go, making sure that different children get turns. They will listen to others and include ideas suggested.

From Article 24

All children have the right to a drink of clean water during lessons as long as it does not disturb the lesson.

The children will use the independent working or transition times to have a drink.

Teachers will permit the children to drink from the tap or their bottles at appropriate times.

From Article 31

All the children of 6W have the right to join in a wide range of cultural and artistic activities.

Adults could look to check that all children are participating and make sure that a range of activities are delivered.

Children should try their best to participate and attend.
