Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had a really productive week at the school. The Local Authority Review of the school on Monday has identified next steps to secure the continued improvement in the school. They noted the improvements in the environment and also in the behaviour in the school. They were also able to review data which showed the impact of Read, Write, Inc. in Years 1 and 2.

We are now going to continue to focus on provision for children with special educational needs and higher attaining pupils to make sure that the tasks set are tailored to their needs and also challenge them.

On another note, we continue to have concerns about pupils misusing social media sites and messaging apps. Please could we appeal to all parents to check at least every other day what your child is doing on their electronic devices. We will talk to pupils in school about using these sites and remind them of the age restrictions on some sites. You will have heard in the news today that a survey has shown the negative impact use of social media sites has on young people's mental health.

Thank you to Sarah Deed who has been working hard to organise the Summer Fair for the school. The funds raised through PTA events will be used to improve the school on items which we would not normally be able to afford. Please could you show your support by offering to help with this event. There are currently only a handful of parents out of the 414 pupils who are involved so far.
