



Dear Parents,

The weather has finally decided to be sunny and so we can begin to enjoy Spring!

In this week's staff meeting we have been looking at behaviour for learning. This includes children being ready to learn and also some key skills needed for life. For example, being able to listen and follow instructions and being able to concentrate and being able to take risks and accept challenges.

As the weather improves, I just wanted to remind parents and carers about uniform and especially footwear. Open toed sandals do pose a risk for children. The children will lift up and sit down on their chairs and this does mean that there is a chance that the chair leg could be put down on a child's toes and with their weight. For this reason, we have to insist that children have their toes covered and do not wear sandals to school.

We continue to have a few children who are dropped off or arrive at school before 8:35am. We will be pursuing parents and carers and their care arrangements and for the reason behind this and remind everyone that children are to be supervised by their parents at all times whilst on the playground. A parent has reported that children have been seen running around the streets and putting themselves at risk both before and after school.

Finally, our Core Value this term is Celebration and we continue to celebrate all of the excellent work in the school. Last week we had our new round of Super Citizens and we are extremely proud of the children who continue to live our values through their behaviour and choices. Well done to:

Please note the school is closed this Bank Holiday Monday.


Dinner money
