Article 19 - Children have the right to not be hurt in anyway.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Making sure we respect the rights of other children both in the classroom and on the playground at break and lunch times.</li><li>• By making the right choices of how to deal with a situation respectfully when someone upsets us.</li><li>• We will tell an adult if someone hurts us so that they can sort out the problem.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• By listening to children if they have a problem or if they think something is unfair.</li><li>• Making sure that all children are treated fairly.</li><li>• We will look after children on the playground and make sure they are kept safe.</li></ul>
Article 24 - Children have the right to good quality health care, to clean water, nutritious food, and a clean environment so that they will stay healthy.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To fill up our water bottles every day and turn off the tap when we are finished so we don't waste water.</li><li>• We will work together to do our class jobs every day to keep our classroom clean and tidy.</li><li>• Remind ourselves to make healthy choices at playtime and lunchtime</li><li>• We will not waste food</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Making sure children have time during the day to have water.</li><li>• Let children go to the toilet when they need to.</li><li>• Make sure the classroom is a safe and clean place to be.</li></ul>
Article 28 - Children have the right to a primary education.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• By respecting the teachers and LSAs who are helping us learn</li><li>• By respecting the other children and helping them to learn too by not distracting them.</li><li>• Bring in the right things you need to learn e.g. PA kit or homework</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Making sure children have fun and exciting lessons in which they learn lots.</li><li>• By respecting the children in the class and listening to their opinions.</li></ul>
